GOSPEL READING*Paying Taxes to Caesar*

Matthew 22:15-22

¹⁵ Then the Pharisees went and plotted how to entangle him in his words. ¹⁶ And they sent their disciples to him, along with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that you are true and teach the way of God truthfully, and you do not care about anyone's opinion, for you are not swayed by appearances. ¹⁷ Tell us, then, what you think. Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?" ¹⁸ But Jesus, aware of their malice, said, "Why put me to the test, you hypocrites? ¹⁹ Show me the coin for the tax." And they brought him a denarius. ²⁰ And Jesus said to them, "Whose likeness and inscription is this?" ²¹ They said, "Caesar's." Then he said to them, "Therefore render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." ²² When they heard it, they marveled. And they left him and went away.

In our text for today, Jesus reminds us of the need to honor and obey "Caesar," i.e., the governing authorities whom God has placed over us. Yet, He also reminds us of the need to honor and obey God. Does this create conflict or divided loyalties? How are Christians to approach their relationship to the nation where they live? Discuss with someone what it means to be a Christ follower in service to a nation but in obedience to God. For further reflection, read 1 Timothy 1:1-4, Romans 13:1-7, and Psalm 146:3-7.

THE WORDS OF OUR LORD


